

Meet Our Juror: Ken Goldman



Ken Goldman is an internationally known artist, author, teacher and art juror. A recipient of numerous awards, Goldman has

exhibited widely in various group shows and solo exhibitions in Holland, Paris, Italy, Greece, China, Colombia, Mexico, New York, Boston, Washington D.C., and recently throughout China.

Goldman's work is included in the permanent collections of *San Diego Museum of Fine Art*, *Hilbert Museum of California Art*, *North Carolina's Hickory Museum of Fine Art*, the *Zuo Wen Museum* in Qindao China, the *San Diego Museum of Natural History* and the *San Diego Watercolor Society*.

The author of twelve instructional books on Pastels, Acrylics, Charcoal and Artistic Anatomy, Goldman has also been featured in several magazines, including *The Art of Watercolour*, *Southwest Art*, *International Artist*, *Watercolor Magic*, *Splash 12, 13 & 19* and *The Artist's Magazine*, among others. Ken is Past-President of the National Watercolor Society and is represented by CaliforniaWatercolor.com Gallery.

Eligibility

The show is open to all artists. Art works may be in oil, acrylic, water media, mixed media, sculpture, encaustics or similar art media. ***Photographs, digital art, jewelry and other craft items cannot be accepted.*** Each artist may submit up to 3 art works. All art entries must meet these conditions:

1. It is the original work of the submitting artist. No copied works please.
2. It is appropriate to the theme.
3. It has not been exhibited at St. Mark's before.
4. It is suitable for viewing by all ages.

In addition, all art works should have these attributes:

1. Each dimension is less than 5 feet; weight is less than 30 pounds.
2. It must be dry and safe for display.
3. Two dimensional works must be fixed with wire ready for hanging. Works framed between two panes of glass will not be accepted.
4. Sculpture must have stands, hangers, or other appropriate means of presentation. The Committee has a few sculpture stands to loan.

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Awards Ceremony

Artists, their friends, and the general public are invited to attend the Awards Ceremony on Saturday, March 8, 2020 in the sanctuary. The presentation of awards and special music will begin at 3 p.m.

The sanctuary will be open that day to view the show starting at noon.

Entry Fees

\$20 for the first art work.

\$10 each for the second and third work.

Entry fees are payable at the time the works are delivered and are non-refundable. Only cash or checks can be accepted.

Art Sales

The sale of works will be encouraged during the show at the price determined by the artist. St. Mark's expects a commission of 20% of the proceeds.

Insurance

Reasonable care will be exercised in handling your art. However, The Religious Art Show, St. Mark's United Methodist Church and its officers, representatives or agents assume no responsibility for damage, theft, or loss of entries. With entries received being subject to these conditions, insurance is the responsibility of the artist.

Show Hours

The show will be open for free public viewing ***noon to 4pm*** on Saturdays March 7, 14, 21, 28. April 4, and 11.

Artists are encouraged to sit the gallery one Saturday during the show, either 1-3 p.m. or 3-5 p.m. It would be helpful if you would check your calendar and be prepared to sign up at the time you enter your works in the show.
