Monthly Pancake Breakfast	Free to all, Community is always invited (when allowed once pandemic started)
PPE Masks	Given to community upon request
San Diego Police Department	Officers invited to take breaks/do paperwork in St. Mark's office (until pandemic started)
Scripps Green Hospital	Pastoral/canine therapy team donated 4 hrs/wk until pandemic hit in March
St. Mark's Preschool	Provided teacher appreciation gift bags to all teachers/staff
Storefront (halfway house for homeless teens)	complete homecooked meals for teens, 4th Monday every month (until pandemic started)
Upper Room Daily Devotionals	Sent to all who request them
Yoga Classes	Offered to the community two mornings per week (went virtual in March)
